Person being hit by golf ball or golf club	Participants/sup porting adults and staff	Minor Injuries-Harmful	Possible	Substantial	<p>Safety briefing to be carried out before the event begins</p> <p>Ensure that at safe distance is kept between the player hitting the ball and those waiting for their turn to tee off</p> <p>Ensure that all participants and supporting adults are aware of the use of "Fore" when a ball is heading towards other people on the course.</p> <p>Ensure the green is clear before the next group take their tee shots.</p> <p>Ensure the pair furthest away from the hole take their shot first.</p>	Acceptable

Children falling over	Participants	Minor Injuries	Possible	Moderate	The activity involves walking between each hole. All surfaces to be checked to make sure they are clean, free from rubbish and not slippery and provide the most direct route which avoids any unnecessary hazards.	Acceptable
Children left alone with adults	Participants	Harmful- 1 2 1 with a minor	Unlikely	Moderate	Participants will always play in pairs on the course and will be playing alongside a pair from another golf club All participants will be supervised by a parent/guardian throughout their time at the event.	Acceptable
Physical Injury	Participants	Slightly Harmful- Minor Injuries	Unlikely	Low	All participants will be encouraged to ensure they warm-up before the event begins. Team Managers and parents should be aware of any child's medical history / disability. All equipment used is suitable for the children's ages.	Acceptable

General well-being of participants	Participants	Slightly Harmful	Unlikely	Low	<p>Ensure that all participants have water bottles, especially if the weather is very hot and signposted to where these can be refilled.</p> <p>Ensure that all participants are perpared for all weather situations.</p> <p>Make sure that toilets are clearly signposted</p> <p>Ensure that all participants and parents are given a map of the course so they are aware of the 6 holes to be played and the route to follow.</p>	Acceptable
